Bold and earth-shattering, the 2017 Earthquake Petite Sirah opens with aromas of blackberry jam, toasted marshmallow and cracked black pepper. Concentrated flavors of baked boysenberry pie, plum, nutmeg and hickory carry through the velvety, layered finish.

HISTORY

Over the top and shattering to the veins! These wines possess major concentration and daring flavor. The original is the Earthquake Zin which came from an old Lodi vineyard planted around the same time of San Francisco's great Earthquake of 1906. While mulling over a label name in the vineyard, Michael Phillips thought it only seemed fitting to relate this intense wine with the historical quake. These dark and voluminous wines will definitely leave your senses quivering...
