TASTING NOTES

Like ink spilling out of its well, this 2019 Petite Sirah overflows with blackberry, maple and floral aromas leading to a mouth filling effect and richness on the palate. Flavors of ripe red plum, molasses and dark chocolate carry this wine to a long, spice-laden finish.

HISTORY

Known for giving a platform to grapes that are usually under appreciated and used as “blending varietals,” the newest addition to our Inkblot family is none other than Petite Sirah. A favorite among our winemakers, Petite Sirah can be found in many of our wines for its concentration and color, but as a stand alone varietal this grape is seriously impressive! Give it a try and we think you’ll agree that Petite Sirah was a natural fit for this brand that celebrates bold, inky and teeth-staining wines.
