# TASTING NOTES

With fruit handpicked from Phillips family vineyards, this 2019 Cabernet displays aromas of wild raspberries, cherry, sandalwood and anise. Medium in body, flavors of strawberry, dried fruit and pipe tobacco drive the wine to a long, concentrated finish showcasing notes of French oak and vanilla.

### **HISTORY**

Sustainably produced from Phillips family Vineyards, our namesake Cabernet Sauvignon is blended with a modest amount of Petit Verdot and highlights the varietal's sophistication and elegance. Aged in French oak barrels, this wine shows great depth, roundness, and overall structure. While you can drink now, this wine will continue to mature for years to come.
