TASTING NOTES

With two years of primarily new French oak barrel aging, our 2020 Michael David Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon is truly something we are proud to put our family name on. Bold and lusciously complex, this wine opens with juicy plum, huckleberry pie, Mexican chocolate and cinnamon. On the palate, the flavors are both opulent and robust, with Mission fig, molasses, tobacco and freshly ground clove carried through by a long, dynamic finish.

HISTORY

As a winery known for producing out of this world Cabernet Sauvignon, this wine represents the very best selection of Phillips family-owned vineyards. Hailing from the Armstrong Vineyard planted back in the 1980s, this Cabernet Sauvignon is closely monitored by our winemakers throughout the entire process. From pampering in the vineyard through crop thinning, to closely monitored fermentations in the cellar and handselected premium French oak barrel aging, we are proud to put our name on the high quality end result in bottle.
