TASTING NOTES

With two years of primarily new French oak barrel aging, our 2021 Michael David Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon is a beautiful representation of the high-quality Cabernet sourced from Phillips family vineyards. Bold and lusciously complex, this wine opens with juicy plum, red licorice and dark chocolate caramel truffle. Bold and robust, flavors of blackberry, honey and spiced tobacco are revealed, with notes of dried fruit and red berry cobbler emerging on the lush, dynamic finish.

HISTORY

As a winery known for producing out of this world Cabernet Sauvignon, this wine represents the very best selection of Phillips family-owned vineyards. Hailing from the Armstrong Vineyard planted back in the 1980s, this Cabernet Sauvignon is closely monitored by our winemakers throughout the entire process. From pampering in the vineyard through crop thinning, to closely monitored fermentations in the cellar and handselected premium French oak barrel aging, we are proud to put our name on the high quality end result in bottle.
