Rapture Cabernet Sauvignon

TASTING NOTES

Deep garnet in the glass, this luscious small lot offering beckons aromas of huckleberry, espresso and floral notes on the nose. On the palate, this full-bodied 2023 Cabernet Sauvignon reveals complex layers of fresh blackberry, brown sugar and mocha, with harmonious notes of light caramel and nutmeg emerging on the lush, lingering finish.

HISTORY

Similar to 1st growth Bordeaux, Rapture is only produced on exceptional vintage years. The grapes for this wine come from Michael Phillips' own vineyard, which is rotary fermented and aged for 18 months in premium oak barrels. Meanwhile, David Phillips gave this wine its creative identity by using the biblical name Rapture. With the limited production of this wine, "Don't be left behind!"
