TASTING NOTES

Like ink spilling across a page, our 2023 Inkblot Cabernet Franc commands attention with unapologetic intensity. Opening with decadent aromas of blackberry, fresh molasses cookie and cassis, full bodied flavors of cherry preserves and toasted cloves are layered with hints of peppery spice and a lasting impression of concentration and complexity.

HISTORY

The first Cabernet Franc wine ever produced by Michael David Winery and one of the few produced from Lodi, this varietal originated from the Bordeaux and Loire Valley regions of France and has been grown with success in many other countries. The grapes for this wine come from a 9 acre vineyard located on the west side of Lodi, no more than a stone's throw away from the winery. Ready to drink now or could be set down for a few years.
