TASTING NOTES

As inky as the name suggests, our 2023 Inkblot Petite Sirah is full in body and teeth-staining purple in color! This wine has expressive aromas of violet, blueberry and nutmeg. Rich layers of black cherry, s'mores and pepper tantalize while leading to a long, satisfying finish of dark fruit and velvety smooth tannins.

HISTORY

Known for giving a platform to grapes that are usually under appreciated and used as “blending varietals,” the newest addition to our Inkblot family is none other than Petite Sirah. A favorite among our winemakers, Petite Sirah can be found in many of our wines for its concentration and color, but as a stand alone varietal this grape is seriously impressive! Give it a try and we think you'll agree that Petite Sirah was a natural fit for this brand that celebrates bold, inky and teeth-staining wines.
